Enter one of the qualifying classes at this show: Classes - 451, 452, 460, 461, 462, 463, 465, 466, 467, 468, 469, 470, 471, 472, 473, 474, 475, 476, 477, 478, 479, 480, 481, 482, 483, 484.

If you are placed first or second in the class, you should be given a qualifying card.

- 1) Fill in the information required on the front of the card.
- 2) Register with Showing Scene if not already registered. This is Free
- 3) Join SWPA via www.showingscene.com as a 2026 Member
- 4) Take a picture of the card and upload to the relevant Championship Class

(Championship Classes are 1 – 134 on Saturday of the Championships)

Please Note: Membership Fee for the 2026 Championships is £25 which includes two adults and all children at the same address and all equines owned or leased by the family.

All NPS Qualifying Rounds:

These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in any of the British Riding Pony studbook sections or the Ridden Register; the GSB; the AHSB; the AASB, or registered in the main body of their respective M&M Stud Book. Part bred are not eligible unless over stamped into one of the British Riding Pony studbook sections. or the Ridden Register. Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and nonmembers but only ponies owned by adult NPS Qualifying or Life members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern in August 2026. The highest placed pony, if owned by an NPS member, in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified. NPS/WTJ Insurance Brokers Ltd Home Produced Ridden Championship - Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies, if owned by NPS members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show. The Owner's Membership cards MUST be produced in the ring when requested or the qualification will be forfeit.

NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championships: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the owner of the champion pony is a Qualifying or Life member of the NPS. A valid membership card must be in the rider's/handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the owner of the Champion pony is not a member, or the owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette, but the qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the owner of that pony is a member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships.

RULES OF THE FROME & DISTRICT AGRICULTURAL SOCIETY & HORSE SECTION

1. **PRIZE AWARDS.** In classes with only one entry, the Committee reserves the right to award 2nd Prize money only, if in the opinion of the Judge the entry is of insufficient merit to justify 1st Prize. No 2nd Prize will be awarded in any class in which there are less than 3 entries or 3rd unless there are at least four entries. No 4th Prize will be awarded unless the entries exceed 10. Any horse may be exhibited in more than one class except where stated. The Society will award Rosettes up to 6th place at the discretion of the section Secretary.
 2. **CUPS:** A £30 deposit will be taken for those wishing to take cups home this will be returned when the cups are returned prior to the 2026 show.
 3. Each Exhibitor will receive from the designated Secretary a printed number, without which no horse will be admitted. ALL competitors must display the correct number for each horse.
 4. The Society operates a Health and Safety policy on the Showground. All riders must wear protective headgear. The Frome Agricultural & Cheese Show strongly recommends the wearing of a skull cap manufactured to the relevant current BSI Standard, which in the arena must be worn with a plain dark coloured peaked cover, or a riding cap to the relevant current BSI Standard. The Frome Agricultural & Cheese Show recommends the wearing of protective headgear whilst leading any horse or pony. Such headgear must be worn with a chin strap correctly and securely fastened at all times whilst mounted on the showground. The Society shall not be liable for any loss (whether for death or personal injury or for any consequential or indirect loss suffered) in relation to the protective helmets worn by riders and in particular but without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing any failure by riders to wear protective helmets to the recommended standard.
 5. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry or restrict the number of entries in any class.
 6. In restricted Classes, the radius mentioned, to be reckoned from the Showground to the Competitors permanent place of residence. If disputed this shall be measured by the Chairman of the Horse Section or his deputy upon the Ordnance Survey Map belonging to the Society and their decision shall be final.
 7. All entry fees quoted in this schedule are inclusive of VAT at the standard rate of 20%.
 8. If due to unforeseen circumstances the selected Judge is unable to fulfill their commitment, the Committee reserves the right to appoint an alternative Judge at short notice (after printing of the schedule), without informing Competitors prior to the start of the show.
 9. 2 admission tickets will be issued per horse entered with 1 lorry pass issued per entry form.
 10. Passports with up to date inoculations must be presented at the Horse Admin tent on arrival. Failure to do so will result in you being asked to leave the showground immediately.
 11. **No jewellery to be worn by competitors.**
 12. **All competitors and grooms entering the competition rings are required to wear presentable clothing and appropriate headgear.**
