Vintage Vehicle Section – Terms & Conditions 2026

1. Vehicles must fit into one of the official sections: Vintage Cars, Vintage Bikes, Commercial Vintage Vehicles, Agricultural Vintage Vehicles, or Stationary Vintage Engines.
2. A £5 entry fee is required per vehicle. Steam Engines are exempt from the entry fee.
3. Entry will not be accepted without payment of the entry fee.
4. One entry form per exhibit. Maximum of 3 entries per exhibitor across all sections.
5. Each entry includes 2 exhibitor tickets for the day of the show.
6. Cash prizes will be awarded to the Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show: £100 for First Prize and £50 for Second Prize. A rosette and prize card will be given to the top three in each category.
7. Failure to arrive, or failure to notify the Society in advance if unable to attend, will result in the exhibitor being barred from entering future shows.
8. All exhibits must be covered by the minimum insurance required by the Road Traffic Act if the vehicle is not excluded from use on public roads.
9. Non-self-propelled vehicles must have public liability insurance with a minimum indemnity of £2,000,000 per incident.
10. Drivers/riders must hold a valid licence appropriate for their vehicle.
11. Exhibitors must operate their vehicles safely and follow the instructions of show stewards at all times.
12. Exhibits should arrive by 8.30am. There is no vehicle movement on the Showground until 5.30pm.
13. Judging will be carried out by an official judge, appointed by the Society.
14. The judges' decision is final. No correspondence or disputes regarding judging will be entered into.
15. Exhibitors are responsible for the safe condition of their vehicles.
16. Vehicles must be roadworthy or otherwise safe to operate on showground surfaces.
17. By entering, exhibitors agree to allow the Society to use photographs of their vehicles for promotional purposes.
18. The Society reserve the right to cancel or refuse any entry without explanation.
19. Entry fees are non-refundable, except in the event of show cancellation.
20. The Society accepts no responsibility or liability for any loss, damage, or theft to vehicles, exhibits, or property while on the showground.
21. Data Protection (GDPR): Personal data provided on this form will be used solely for the administration of the show and will not be shared with third parties.
22. All exhibitors must comply with these rules and any additional instructions issued by the Society.
23. Failure to comply may result in removal from the showground.
